Plaintiff Jonathan Bedford has filed a notice of appeal from the judgment entered in this case on August 30, 2005, dismissing the case with prejudice for plaintiff's failure to pay a sanction imposed upon him on June 6, 2005. Because his notice of appeal is not accompanied by the \$255 fee for filing an appeal, I construe his notice to include a request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. When a party has been granted leave to proceed in the district court, he may proceed in forma pauperis on appeal without further authorization unless the district court certifies that the appeal is not taken in good faith. I do not intend to certify that plaintiff's appeal is not taken in good faith.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal GRANTED.
