We then took evidence on Randle's three-part motion to suppress evidence. Randle must file and serve his first brief in support of his motions not later than September 20, 2005. The government must file and serve its response not later than September 26, 2005,

with any defense reply filed and served not later than September 28, 2005. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
