On June 10, 2004, this court held the preliminary pretrial conference. Defendant James Schlifer was present with his attorney, T. Christopher Kelly. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Paul Connell.

Prior to the hearing, Schlifer filed a series of discovery motions. After accepting a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motion docketed as 13 and denied those docketed as 12 and 14-18. No action was necessary on the discovery requests docketed as 10 and 11, except that the government must disclose expert witnesses by June 28, 2004, with reciprocal defense expert disclosure by July 12, 2004.

We addressed briefly Schlifer's proposal for release on conditions but for reasons stated, I will take no action at this time. The parties should contact the court if they wish to be heard further on this issue. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's

attention. I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
