On April 21, 2005, third party defendant Society Insurance moved to stay all proceedings until the court has determined whether Society Insurance has a duty to defend or indemnify defendant RMTC, Inc. (incorrectly designated as Rib Mountain Travel Center) in this lawsuit. See Dkt. #33.

As a rule, this court does not bifurcate coverage questions or stay other discovery while such motions are pending. When briefing its motion for declaratory judgment, Society Insurance may attempt to show good cause to except this case from the court's default position, but nothing in its initial submissions convinces me that it more just, speedy and inexpensive to put this entire case on hold while briefing and deciding the coverage issue.

ORDER

It is ORDERED that third party defendant Society Insurance 's motion to bifurcate and to stay proceedings is DENIED without prejudice.
