SCHEDULING ORDER

On October 19, 2005, this court held a recorded telephonic scheduling conference. Plaintiff was represented by Attorney Stanley Thorne. Defendants were represented by Assistant Attorney General David C. Rice.

Having missed the previously-set deadline for amending the complaint, plaintiff nonetheless asked for the opportunity to supplement her complaint. As discussed on the record, I gave plaintiff until October 31, 2005, to do a “quick and dirty” supplement to her complaint to add two new claims. Defendants may have until November 30, 2005, within which to respond; this could be either a substantive answer, or more likely, a renewal of their motion to dismiss, incorporating their previous arguments and adding anything new militated by plaintiff’s new claims. In the event of a motion to dismiss, plaintiff may have until December 12, 2005, within which to respond, with defendants’ reply due by December 23, 2005. Due to the relatively tight deadlines, same day or next day service is required for

all submissions covered by this order. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
