Mark Woodard has filed a document styled as a petition for a writ of habeas corpus and has paid the five dollar filing fee. The document is the third in a series in which Woodard complains about the City of Beloit's actions in relation to a municipal citation filed against Woodard for his alleged violation of Beloit's zoning code. Like his previous two submissions, the instant document contains no allegation that the City of Beloit is holding petitioner in illegal custody. Accordingly, the petition will be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner's pleading, styled as a petition for a writ of habeas corpus, is DISMISSED for lack of subject matter jurisdiction.

In the event Woodard files another habeas petition, the clerk of court is directed to route the petition to chambers before opening a new case. If upon reviewing the petition I conclude that it relates to the same subject as this case and that no basis for jurisdiction

exists, I will place the document in the file, return any filing fee paid and take no further action with respect to the petition.
