Plaintiff has filed a document titled "Motion to Cancel Order," in which he asks that the court issue an order directing the Oshkosh Correctional Institution business office to refrain from collecting any further money in his prison account. The court's records reflect that on May 24, 2007, plaintiff paid the remaining balance of \$200 on the \$455 fee he owed for filing an appeal in this case and that he owes no other payments to this court. If plaintiff wishes to make a copy of this order available to prison financial administrators so that they

are aware of what the court's records show, he may do so. An order to cancel a previous

order requiring payment of the fee is unnecessary. If, for any reason, the business office

inadvertently were to send an additional amount from plaintiff's account, this court's

financial program will reject it automatically and the check will be returned to the prison

with a request that no additional money be collected for payment of the fee plaintiff incurred

in this case.

ORDER

Plaintiff's "Motion to Cancel Order" is DENIED as unnecessary.
