Petitioner Aaron A. Kreilkamp has requested leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> in this civil action for injunctive and monetary relief brought under Title VII, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e 2(a)(1). In his complaint, petitioner alleges that defendant Roundy's, Inc., his employer, made him wear a religious medal around his neck, which is contrary to petitioner's religious beliefs, and that when petitioner challenged the requirement, he was harassed.

From the affidavit of indigency accompanying petitioner's proposed complaint, I cannot determine whether petitioner qualifies for indigent status. He has answered "yes" to the question whether he is presently employed, but he has not answered the question how much he is paid.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that a decision whether petitioner Aaron Kreilkamp may proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> in this action is STAYED. Petitioner may have until August 14, 2005, in which to complete the enclosed affidavit of indigency form and return it to the court. Petitioner should take particular care to show how much he earns from his job. If, by August 14, 2005, petitioner fails to provide the requested financial information, I will deny his request for leave to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> for his failure to show that he is indigent.
