Petitioner requests leave to proceed in forma pauperis. Attached to his affidavit of indigency is a proposed complaint.

Petitioner's allegations are not legible. It appears he is claiming that individuals in Espresso Royale, State Street Bar and Einstein Bagels said that he should talk more quietly. This allegation does not support a claim for relief under federal law. 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Accordingly, petitioner's request to proceed in forma pauperis will be dismissed and denied without prejudice.

Petitioner is advised that in any future proceedings in this matter he must offer argument not cumulative of that already provided to undermine this Court's conclusion that his claim must be dismissed. See Newlin v. Helman, 123 F.3d 429, 433 (7<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1997).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner's request to proceed in forma pauperis is DENIED and DISMISSED without prejudice.
