Unfortunately, plaintiff's recent transfer to the Green Bay Correctional Institution was not noted on the court's electronic docket until today, which may mean that plaintiff has not received this court's orders of July 20 and July 24, 2006. (Mailing labels are generated from the electronic docket.) Therefore, I am enclosing copies of those orders to him with this order. In this order, I am denying plaintiff's third "motion for contempt & sanctions" for the reasons expressed in the July 20 order. In addition, I am making it clear to plaintiff that at no time has this court ordered that defendants provide plaintiff with photocopies of portions of the BHS manual he has been allowed to inspect. While the manual was in plaintiff's possession, he was free to hand-copy relevant portions as needed

for his use in connection with this case or to pay for copies at his own expense, if he had sufficient funds in his prison account to do so. Nothing he has submitted in support of his motions for sanctions shows that he has utilized the appropriate procedures for obtaining photocopies at his expense and that his requests have been denied for a reason other than lack of funds. Therefore, there is no basis upon which to find that defendants are in contempt of this court's July 3, 2006 order.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's third motion for contempt and sanctions is DENIED.
