During the January 11, 2006 telephonic pretrial conference, the court discussed with both sides the issue of venue. Defendant David A. Clarke, appearing by Louis Edward Elder, indicated that he intended to file a motion to transfer this case to the Eastern District of Wisconsin as soon as possible. Plaintiff Dionny L. Reynolds, appearing on his own behalf, responded that he does not oppose the motion. Reynolds indicated that he prepared his complaint using boilerplate that probably incorporated the Western District rather than the Eastern District. Reynolds is not claiming that his case belongs in this district and does not oppose its transfer to the Eastern District. Accordingly, Clarke made an oral motion during the hearing to transfer the case; Reynolds did not oppose it.

The motion to transfer venue is GRANTED. The Clerk of Court shall transfer this case to the Eastern District of Wisconsin for further proceedings.
