Rule 8 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure requires a litigant to include in her complaint a short, plain statement of the grounds for this court's jurisdiction and a short, plain statement of the claim the plaintiff is raising. Petitioner did neither of these things when she drafted her complaint. Therefore, in an order dated December 28, 2005, I stayed a decision regarding petitioner's request to proceed in forma pauperis and directed her to supplement her complaint by providing information about what defendant did to her and how she believed its action or actions violated the law. In the same order, I indicated that failure to provide the requested information by January 9, 2005 would result in the dismissal of this case without prejudice to her refile it later. Petitioner has not responded in any way to the December 28 order; therefore, her request to proceed in forma pauperis will be denied

and the case dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that

1. Petitioner's request to proceed in forma pauperis is DENIED and her claim is DISMISSED without prejudice. The clerk of court is directed to close the file.
