ORDER

In response to this court's orders of May 15 and May 25, 2006, petitioner Jeffrey Sulaski has submitted a trust fund account statement so that I may determine whether he qualifies financially for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. From the trust fund account statement petitioner has submitted, I find that he qualifies financially for indigent status, except that he has the means to pay \$5 of the \$455 fee for filing his appeal. Moreover, I do not intend to certify that his appeal is not taken in good faith.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner's request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal is GRANTED on the condition that, no later than July 10, 2006, he submit a check

or money order made payable to the clerk of court in the amount of \$5 as partial payment of the \$455 fee for filing his appeal. If, by July 10, 2006, petitioner fails to pay \$5 as directed by this order, I will notify the court of appeals of that fact so that it may take whatever action it deems appropriate with respect to petitioner's appeal.
