ORDER

At defendant Ritchie E. Bufford's sentencing on July 19, 2005, I found that he was not a flight risk or a danger to the community and gave him until August 9, 2005, in which to report to an institution to begin service of his sentence. In the interim, his previously set bail conditions remained in effect, including the requirement that he reside with his mother at 6525 Raymond Road, Apt. 202, Madison, WI. Later that day, defendant moved for a revision of his conditions of release to allow him to live with the mother of his children, Andrea Gavins, and to switch his electronic monitoring to the new residence. Defendant is concerned that his mother has too many other people living with her at the present time.

From defendant's request, it appears that there may be no adequate and appropriate conditions of release and that it would be advisable to have defendant surrender immediately to begin service of his sentence. To explore this question, I will hold a hearing on the matter on Tuesday, July 26, 2005, at 11:00 a.m.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Ritchie E. Bufford is to appear in person before the court at 11:00 a.m. on July 26, 2005, to show cause if any there be why he should not be ordered to surrender immediately to begin service of the sentence imposed on him on July 19, 2005.
