SCHEDULING ORDER

05-CR-61-S

At the October 11, 2005 telephonic status conference, this court set the following schedule:

1) A competency hearing has been scheduled for November 9, 2005, at 11:00 a.m. Each side must confirm that this date works for its witnesses and must consult with each other about how the evidence will be presented, with any disagreements promptly brought to the court's attention. Following a competency determination we will discuss the need for pretrial motions.

2) Submissions for the final pretrial conference, namely proposed voir dire questions, jury instructions and motions *in limine* must be filed and served not later than January 4, 2006.

3) The final pretrial conference shall be January 6, 2006, at 1:30 p.m. Defendant may waive his presence at the final pretrial conference.

4) The final hearing before the trial judge shall be January 13, 2006, at 3:30 p.m.

The defendant and trial counsel must attend this hearing.

5) Jury selection and trial shall begin at 9:00 a.m. on January 17, 2006. The predicted trial length is one to two days. The parties are jointly responsible for alerting the clerk of court forthwith if a jury need not be called.
