ORDER

05-CR-0064-C

Defendant Nicholas Dimodica was sentenced to 12 months in prison following his conviction on a charge of felon in possession of a firearm in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(1). He surrendered to the Federal Correctional Institution at Waseca, Minnesota on November 14, 2005. On April 7, 2006, the Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit ordered defendant's release pending appeal on the same conditions imposed while he was on pretrial release in the district court. Defendant was released from the custody of the Bureau of Prisons on April 14, 2006.

On November 16, 2006, the court of appeals affirmed defendant's conviction. The mandate was received by this court on December 29, 2006. On January 4, 2007, defendant filed a motion for permission to file a motion for reconsideration. This motion was granted and briefing was set on the motion to end on January 17, 2007.

Pending resolution of defendant's motion for reconsideration, defendant is to remain released subject to the conditions imposed upon him by the United States Magistrate Judge on April 26, 2005.
