On July 28, 2005 this court released defendant Joyce Ann Knopps on conditions. *See* dkt. 17. Among the conditions were that Knopps not use or possess controlled substances and that she not associate with drug users. On September 13, 2005, Knopps tested positive for methamphetamine use. At a subsequent meeting with pretrial services, Knopps admitted that on September 8, 2005 she had used methamphetamine with friends. As a result the government petitioned to revoke Knopps's pretrial release pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3148.

At the September 19, 2005 revocation hearing, Knopps did not contest the petition. Accordingly, I concluded that there is probable cause that Knopps violated her release conditions relating to drug use and that there are no release conditions available that will assure that Knopps can and will remain drug free while her case is pending.

Accordingly, It is ORDERED that defendant Joyce Ann Knopps is committed to the custody of the United States Marshals Service for confinement at a proximate county jail separate from persons awaiting or serving sentences or being held in custody pending appeal.

Knopps shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity for private consultation with her attorney. On order of this court or on request of an attorney for the Government, the jail shall deliver Knopps to the Marshals Service for the purpose of an appearance in this case.
