On December 1, 2005, this court held a recorded telephonic status conference. Defendant Mark Hurn did not participate personally but was represented by his attorney, Mark Eisenberg. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Jeffrey Anderson.

Attorney Eisenberg reported that his competency examiner needs until January 6, 2006, within which to complete his competency examination and report. The government did not object because both sides agree: if Hurn is found competent, he anticipates entering a guilty plea.

Accordingly, the court shall hold a telephonic status conference on January 11, 2006 at 9:45 a.m. with the government placing the conference call to chambers. If necessary, the court will hold a competency hearing on January 18, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. The parties agreed that the examiners may testify telephonically. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.

Time continues to be excluded from computation under the speedy trial clock because Hurn has not yet been determined competent to stand trial.
