Attorney Malloy stated that this was a tactical decision he made in consultation with Mosley after adequate review of the government's disclosures and after adequate review of this case. The government provided a discovery proffer and acknowledged its discovery obligations in this case. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. I will wait to provide draft voir dire

questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
