PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

On October 12, 2005 this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Frederick Jones was present with his attorney, Michael Lieberman. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Meredith Duchemin.

Prior to the hearing Jones filed a motion to dismiss for improper venue (dkt. 9). The government concedes that the documents appear to indicate that the Eastern District of Wisconsin is the appropriate venue for this prosecution. The government needs to follow up with one agent; if that interview goes as predicted, the government will dismiss its indictment and the Eastern District of Wisconsin will take over from there. If the agent says something material and unexpected, then the parties are to contact the court telephonically to determine what needs to happen next. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
