ORDER OF DETENTION
PENDING TRIAL

05-CR-122-S

At the October 6, 2005 status conference on defendant Deborah Lynn Peters's compliance with release conditions, the court learned that Peters has been jailed on a warrant and detainer issued by the State of Minnesota. If this court does not detain Peters in this case, it is likely that she will be extradited to Minnesota and jailed for failure to make bond pending her state trial. To keep the status quo, the parties stipulated that this court may deem Peters a flight risk and detain her on that basis. We can revisit this stipulation if Peters's situation in Minnesota changes.

It is ORDERED that the defendant is committed to the custody of the United States Marshals Service for confinement at the Dane County Jail separate from persons awaiting or serving sentences or being held in custody pending appeal. The defendant shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity for private consultation with her attorney. On order of this court or on request of an attorney for the Government, the Dane County Jail shall deliver the defendant to the Marshals Service for the purpose of an appearance in this case.
