The above entitled matter came before the Court for adjourned sentencing on September 25, 2006, the government having appeared by Erik C. Peterson, United States Attorney for the Western District of Wisconsin, by Elizabeth Altman, Assistant United States Attorney; defendant in person and by Jonas Bednarek. Honorable John C. Shabaz, District Judge, presided.

The Court determined that the three-year period of supervised release proposed in the plea agreement limits the authority of this Court to address the need for lifetime supervision of this defendant. Accordingly, that part of the proposed plea agreement is rejected.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that jury selection and trial is rescheduled to commence November 6, 2006 at 9:00 A.M., counsel to meet with the Court at 8:30 A.M. on said day to resolve issues pending trial.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that there is excluded from the speedy trial act that period from October 31, 2005, the date of the proposed plea agreement, to the November 6, 2006 or thereafter, the adjourned trial date, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(1)(I).
