The government must disclose its expert witnesses not later than January 9, 2006, with reciprocal defense disclosure by January 23, 2006. Because

the parties may resolve this case short of trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
