Recognizing that defendants Michael Robinson, Sr. and Michael Robinson, Jr., are not proper defendants in a case in which plaintiff is alleging violations of the Age Discrimination in Employment Act (ADEA), 29 U.S.C. § 623, as this case does, plaintiff has notified the court that he wishes to dismiss these defendants voluntarily. Because no defendant has yet answered the complaint, plaintiff is free to dismiss his action as to any one or more of the defendants without an order of the court. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1). Therefore, I accept plaintiff's notice of voluntary dismissal of defendants Michael Robinson,

Sr. and Michael Robinson, Jr. The only remaining defendant in this case is Robinson Brothers Environmental, Inc.
