On December 28, 2006, I deemed defendants' motion to preclude experts (dkt. 19) an early motion in limine, but I gave defendants the option of pursuing the motion at this time, so long as they supplemented it with a supporting brief, affidavit, or other document showing a *prima facie* entitlement to the relief requested.

Upon reconsideration, it is clear that both sides (and the court) would benefit from early resolution of this motion. Therefore, I am vesting the "option:" defendants may have until January 8, 2007 within which to file and serve their supplemental documents (including a brief) in support of their motion. Plaintiffs may have until January 18, 2007 within which to file and serve their complete response. Defendants may have until January 23, 2007 within which to file and serve any reply. Same day service is required for all submissions on this motion.
