According to the docket, the court is in the process of deciding whether to allow petitioner to proceed *in forma pauperis* on appeal and whether to issue a certificate of appealability to petitioner. However, it appears that petitioner still needs to supply the court of appeals with a docketing

statement. If he has not already done so, petitioner should provide the court of appeals with a docketing statement as soon as possible.
