In this action, petitioner Gary Campbell seeks leave to proceed in forma pauperis on a claim that respondents are interfering with his mail and depriving him of his right of access to the courts. In addition, he expresses concern that respondents may place him in segregation status because of his complaints. Neither of these issues raises a concern that petitioner is under imminent danger of serious physical injury. Therefore, for the reasons expressed in this court's order entered today in another case filed by petitioner, Campbell

v. Clarke, 06-C-148-C, petitioner's request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis is DENIED.
