He alleges that he was denied prescription medication and a religious diet. He also alleges he was punished without due process. Accordingly, he will be allowed to proceed in forma pauperis on these claims.

## ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that plaintiff will be allowed to proceed on his claims against the defendants.
