MEMORANDUM

06-C-331-C

Bernard Seidling has written the court, objecting to defendants' removal of his action from the Circuit Court for Sawyer County. This filing appears to have crossed in the mail with this court's order of July 6, 2006, in which I directed Seidling to file no later than July

20, 2006, an affidavit stating under penalty of perjury that he is the exclusive owner of plaintiff Redline Services. Alternatively, Seidling is to enter a notice of appearance of a lawyer who will represent plaintiff in this court. Until it is clear whether Seidling is the sole owner of plaintiff Redline Services, I cannot consider any documents filed by Seidling.

Even if I could consider Seidling's submission, I would construe it as a motion for remand and deny the motion. Seidling's objection to removal is that "the federal statutes which defendants violated are similar in nature to the state statutes" and that the motive behind the removal is defendants' "hope[] that plaintiff will not have the financial resources to continue." Apparently, plaintiff does not understand that this court has supplemental jurisdiction to hear any state law claims he raises in his complaint that arise out of the same facts that form the basis for his federal law claims. Therefore, he will not need to litigate his federal claims in federal court and his state law claims in state court. All of the claims may be heard in this court.
