On July 25, 2008, this court held a telephonic status conference. Prior to the hearing, the government moved to set an August 6, 2008 deadline by which the United States could file a Statement of Interest. *See* Dkt. 77. That done, the government chose not to participate directly in the status conference. The parties who did participate did not object to the government's request so long as the August 6 deadline is firm and the government's submission was complete, that is, that any Statement of Interest was accompanied by all supporting briefs and other documents. The parties also asked for 14 days after filing of any Statement of Interest within which to file their own response.

I granted both requests. The government's deadline for filing a Statement of Interest and all supporting briefs and documents is August 6, 2008. Any response from any other

party must be filed and served by August 22, 2008. What happens next depends on what the parties' submit. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
