Petitioner has filed fifteen subpoenas which he requests the United States Marshal serve. The United States Marshal will serve the subpoenas only if ordered to do so by the Court. In this case a review of the record indicates that the subpoenas would not gather information relevant to the issues to be decided. Accordingly, petitioner's request to have the United States Marshal serve the subpoenas will be denied.

Petitioner requests a 60 day extension to file his traverse which was to be filed on October 24, 2006. The Court will partially grant his request until November 27, 2006.
