On October 6, 2006 the Court dismissed the above entitled matter without prejudice for plaintiff's failure to pay his initial partial filing fee. The fee was subsequently received. The Court will consider the payment of the fee as a motion to reconsider and will address the merits of plaintiff's complaint.

Although not completely clear, plaintiff appears to be alleging that a private individual rented a room to his family and discriminated against plaintiff because of the race of his mother's boyfriend. These allegations are insufficient to support any claim for relief under federal law by plaintiff. Accordingly, this case will not be reopened.
