ORDER

On September 8, 2006 plaintiff filed this lawsuit regarding payment of retrospective insurance premiums. On October 13, 2006, the parties tersely stipulated to an extension of time for defendant to file its responsive pleading. The court accepted the stipulation and provided until November 15, 2006 for defendant to weigh in. On November 14, 2006, defendant filed a motion for an extension of time until December 15, 2006 within which to file its responsive pleading. Plaintiff does not oppose the motion. The parties do not explain why another extension is necessary.

Having no basis by which to determine that there is good cause to tolerate yet another delay at the outset of this case, the court declines to wait another month to get this case moving. Defendant may have until December 1, 2006 within which to file its response.
