In an order dated October 5, 2006, I gave petitioner James G. Dudgeon, a deadline of October 29, 2006, in which to pay \$19.60 as an initial partial payment of the \$350 fee for filing his complaint in this action. On October 19, 2006, the court received a check in the amount of \$10 to be applied to the requirement payment. Now petitioner has filed a request for an enlargement of time to submit the remainder of the payment. That request will be granted.

According to petitioner, he will not receive a paycheck from his prison job until November 1, 2006. At that time, he believes he will have sufficient funds to pay the remaining \$9.60 he owes this court.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that petitioner may have an enlargement of time to November 13, 2006, in which to submit a check or money order made payable to the clerk of court in the amount of \$9.60. If, by November 13, 2006, petitioner fails to make the payment or show cause for his failure to do so, he will be held to have withdrawn this action voluntarily. In that event, the clerk of court is directed to close this file without prejudice to petitioner's filing his case at a later date.
