On November 6, 2006, I entered an order directing respondent Humphreys to respond to the petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed by petitioner Alvernice Sellers. In response to that order, petitioner filed a letter asking this court to review certain documents attached to the petition which, according to petitioner, show that he requested numerous documents listed on a "Demand and Discovery" request during state court postconviction proceedings. I infer that petitioner is responding to the portion of my order voicing my suspicion that petitioner might not have properly presented all of his issues to the state courts. Duly noted. However, petitioner will have the opportunity to make this and other arguments in response to respondent's answer to the petition, which respondent has not filed yet. For the time being, arguments relating to the merits of the petition are premature.

Accordingly, the court will take no action with respect to petitioner's November 8 letter.
