ORDER

On March 12, 2009, defendant filed a motion asking this court for a one-week extension of the March 13 deadline to file dispositive motions in this case. In his affidavit in support of the motion, Assistant United States Attorney Richard Humphrey says that recent delays in communicating with plaintiff, who is in custody in Rochester, Minnesota, and unavailability of office staff have prevented him from timely preparing and filing a motion for summary judgment. In addition, Mr. Humphrey contends that a modest extension will not significantly delay the progress of this case or impact the trial, which is scheduled for August 10, 2009. Although it is unfortunate defendant waited until the last minute to ask for an extension of the dispositive motion deadline, I agree that an enlargement of one week's time will not unduly impede the resolution of this case.

Therefore, I will grant defendant's motion for a one-week extension of time in which to file its motion for summary judgment.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant's motion for a one-week extension of time to file its motion for summary judgment, dkt. #35, is GRANTED.
