ORDER

06-CR-0005-C

Defendant Anthony H. Andrews has asked for modification of the restitution order entered in this case on August 16, 2006 requiring him to make a payment of \$40,000 toward his restitution at such time as he can sell his house in Burnett County, Wisconsin. (The original order required him to make the payment no later than February 16, 2007.) The motion will be granted.

Defendant has made a persuasive showing that despite vigorous efforts, he has been unable to sell his house. Therefore, I will modify the requirement as requested, provided that defendant continues his efforts to sell the house. I will wait until the house has been sold and defendant knows the amount of the sale proceeds to decide whether to grant defendant's additional request to modify the requirement that defendant make a lump sum

payment of \$40,000 toward restitution.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Anthony H. Andrews's motion to modify his restitution requirement is GRANTED. The judgment and conviction order entered on August 16, 2006, is modified to provide that defendant is not required to make a lump sum payment of \$40,000 to the clerk of court until he has sold his house in Burnett County, Wisconsin. In all other respects, the order remains as entered on August 16, 2006.
