ORDER

A hearing was held on September 21, 2006, on the government's motion to revoke defendant Larry Hendrix's release on conditions pending sentencing. The government appeared by Paul Connell. Defendant was present in person and by counsel, Richard Coad and Thomas Wilmouth.

Defendant stipulated that he did not contest the allegations contained in the memorandum prepared by the United States Probation Office. These allegations identified violations of defendant's conditions, including his failure to meet with defendant's pretrial services officer as directed (a violation of condition no. 4), his failure to submit to urinalysis as directed by the pretrial services office (a violation of condition no. 18), and his failure to remain at 2446 Allied Drive, #2, Madison, Wisconsin during all non-treatment hours except

as approved in advance by the pretrial services officer (a violation of condition no. 22).

Defendant's undisputed violations of the conditions of his release on conditions require revocation of his release. Defendant will be confined pending his sentencing hearing.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Larry Hendrix's release on conditions pending sentencing is REVOKED.
