In response to the defendants' joint motion for relief from the government's lis pendens on their real property, the parties have negotiated a settlement which they have reported to the court in a series of unscheduled and unrecorded telephone calls.

The government has reported to the court that in the event that either defendant or both defendants are found or plead guilty in this case, at any subsequent sentencing the government will seek total restitution no greater than \$71,890 and it will seek a fine or fines totaling not more than \$28,110 for both defendants. The government has agreed to be bound by this \$100,000 limit in order to provide the Rozeks an opportunity to persuade a lender to lend them money against their house notwithstanding the lis pendens so that they may attempt to hire private attorneys. This court is willing to put its imprimatur on this agreement by entering the instant order. It is now up to the Rozeks promptly to follow through.

## **ORDER**

Pursuant to the agreement between the government and the defendants, it is ORDERED that at any sentencing(s) in this case, the government shall be LIMITED to seeking restitution totaling no more than \$71,890, and to seeking fines for both defendants totaling no more than \$28,110, for a total monetary claim by the government against both Jeffrey Rozek and Sandra Rozek at any subsequent sentencings of not more than \$100,000.
