ORDER

06-cr-115-bbc

Defendant Delon Waller has filed a motion pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582, seeking a reduction of the sentence entered on December 31, 2008. The motion will be granted.

When defendant was sentenced in 2008, his term of imprisonment was 136 months, which was at the midpoint of the sentencing guideline range of 121 to 151 months. Under the amended guidelines, defendant has an advisory guideline range of 100 to 125 months.

Defendant has asked for a sentence of 100 months, at the bottom of the amended sentencing range. The government argues for a decrease to approximately the midpoint of the amended range or 112 months.

I am persuaded that a sentence at approximately the midpoint of the amended guideline range is reasonable and sufficient to protect the community, provide defendant the

opportunity for substance abuse counseling and other rehabilitative programs, including vocational training, and achieve parity with the sentences of similarly situated offenders.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the judgment and commitment order entered on December 31, 2008 is AMENDED to provide that the sentence imposed on defendant Delon Waller is reduced to 112 months. In all other respects, the judgment and commitment order remains as entered on December 31, 2008.
