Defendant Romelle Ross has filed a notice of appeal from the court's October 22, 2010 order denying his request for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal and for a certificate of appealability. App. P. 22(b), if defendant wishes to challenge the denial of a certificate of appealability, he must request a circuit judge to issue the certificate.
