ORDER

06-CR-141-S-1

On September 18, 2006 this court held a hearing on defendant Walter L. Burnley's motion for release on conditions. After hearing proffers and arguments from both sides, I concluded that the government had met its burden of establishing that Burnley is a flight risk and a danger to the community, and that the proposed release plan does not sufficiently mitigate these concerns. The evidence against Burnley in this multiple-bank robbery prosecution is solid if not overwhelming. Burnley's long criminal record, particularly his penchant for violating probation, establishes that he cannot be trusted to comply with conditions of release. Accordingly, the previously-issued detention order remains in place..
