Defendant Jerry Lee Ward has filed a motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582, seeking a modification of the sentence imposed upon him on March 13, 2007. He has also asked for appointment of counsel. His motion will be denied. Defendant filed a previous § 3582 motion on March 3, 2008, which was denied on February 11, 2009, because he had been sentenced as career offender and therefore was not eligible for a reduction. Defendant appealed that order and the appeal was dismissed on April 3, 2009.

On August 1, 2011, defendant filed yet another motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582, which was denied on December 2, 2011.

The current motion is defendant's third attempt to file a motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582. Nothing has changed since the entry of both previous orders. Therefore defendant's

motion will be DENIED.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Jerry Lee Ward's motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582 is DENIED as is his motion for appointment of counsel.
