PRETRIAL MOTIONS
HEARING ORDER

06-CR-165-S

On November 21, 2006, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Chad Scott was present with his attorney, Patrick Stangl. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Rita Rumbelow.

Prior to the hearing, Scott filed a series of discovery demands and motions. After taking a discovery proffer from the government, I denied the motions docketed as 13-16, and took no action on the demands docketed as 10-13, except to require government disclosure of expert witnesses not later than December 22, 2006, with reciprocal defense expert disclosure by January 8, 2007. At this point, it is unclear whether Scott will be going to trial. I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions to the parties until closer to their submission deadline for the final pretrial conference. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
