On November 21, 2006, this court held a telephonic pretrial motions hearing. Defendant Grayland Harvey, Jr. did not participate personally, but was represented by his attorney, Richard Coad. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Timothy O'Shea.

Prior to the hearing, Harvey filed no pretrial motions. Attorney Coad stated that this was a tactical decision he made in consultation with his client after adequate review of the government's disclosures and after adequate investigation of the case. The government then provided a discovery proffer. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. Because the parties anticipate resolving this case short of trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
