PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

On November 9, 2006 this court held the pretrial motion hearing and an evidentiary hearing. Defendant Richard Ryerson was present with his attorneys Dean Strang and Erik Guenther. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Meredith Duchemin.

After a brief discovery proffer, we moved directly to the evidentiary hearing. The parties have agreed to the following briefing schedule: first defense brief filed and served not later than November 20, 2006 at noon; government response by November 29, 2006 at noon; defense reply not later than December 1, 2006 at noon. Same-hour service is required. The court will issue a Report and Recommendation not later than December 4, 2006. The parties have agreed to shorten their statutory objection time so that objections will be filed and served not later than December 11, 2006. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
