Defendant Melvin D. Jackson has asked for some breathing room in the schedule to finalize an anticipated plea agreement with the government. The government does not oppose this request.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that the remainder of the schedule in Jackson's case is STRICKEN. The court will hold a telephonic status conference with counsel on February 23, 2007 at 8:45 a.m., with the government initiating the conference call to chambers. If the parties have not scheduled a change of plea hearing by that date, then the court will re-set the schedule for a prompt trial. (The court will not allow Jackson to tag-along with co-defendant Gregory Burks, who has not even appeared yet in this case).
