PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

On December 14, 2006, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Dustin Pascoe was present with his attorney, William Jones. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Paul Connell.

Prior to the hearing, Pascoe filed a series of discovery motions. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motion docketed as 13, and denied 11, 12, 14 and 15. The government may have until December 15, 2006 within which to disclose any expert witnesses. Pascoe may have until December 29, 2006 for reciprocal disclosure of expert witnesses. Not later than December 29, 2006, the parties shall exchange the usual pretrial evidentiary submissions, such as Rule 404(b) proffers, Rule 609 records, *etc.* The parties may submit bench memos to the court not later than January 8, 2007. In the event that Mr. Pascoe were to plead guilty or be found guilty after trial, the court would sentence him that same day.
