PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

On March 19, 2007 this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Ralph Shannon was present with his attorney Anthony C. Delyea. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Laura Przybylinski Finn.

Prior to the hearing Shannon filed no pretrial motions. Attorney Delyea explained the thought process behind this decision with which Shannon concurred and which involved a thorough review of the government's disclosures and sufficient independent investigation of this case. Shannon did not need a discovery proffer from the government and had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. Because this case likely will result in a change of plea, I will wait to provide the draft voir questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
