PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

06-CR-193-C

On January 9, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Eric Olson was present with his attorney, Alan Habermehl. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Peter Jarosz.

Prior to the hearing, Olson filed a series of discovery requests and motions, as well as motions to dismiss and to suppress evidence. After taking a discovery proffer and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motion docketed as 15, denied 13-14 and 16-20, took no action on the requests docketed as 11-12, and set for briefing the motions docketed as 21-24. Olson may have until January 26, 2007 within which to file and serve briefs in support. The government may have until February 8, 2007 within which to file and serve its responses. Olson may have until February 14, 2007 within which to file and serve any replies. Same-day service is required. The government must disclose any expert witnesses not later than February 5, 2007, with reciprocal defense expert witness disclosure not later than February 20, 2007.

The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. I will provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions to the parties closer to their submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
